### OPEN & CONTINUOUS

**NATURE OF WORK:** The Maryland Port Administration (MPA) has openings for positions in the MPA Electro-Mechanical Crane Technician I (Electrical & Mechanical Options) classification at the Maryland Port Administration Marine Facilities. These are entry level work maintaining, inspecting, and repairing cranes. Incumbents will learn the unique electrical, electronic, and mechanical components of container, portal and whirley cranes and learn to provide oversight to crane operations in order to troubleshoot mechanical problems and minimize down time. These positions will perform work in all types of weather, at extreme heights, in cramped spaces, on container cranes which are continually exposed to high noise levels from cranes, ships, and truck engines. The work requires strenuous physical activity such as climbing, bending and lifting tools and equipment weighing over 50 pounds. Incumbents will be considered essential and safety sensitive and may be subject to emergency recall 24 hours a day.

#### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from a high school or possession of high school equivalency certificate.

**EXPERIENCE:** Four years of experience performing testing, calibration, inspection, repair, and maintenance of electrical and/or mechanical apparatus.

**NOTE:** Education at an accredited college, university, or vocational-technical post-secondary school in electrical, electronics or industrial maintenance may be substituted for up to two years of the required experience at a rate of thirty credit hours for each year of experience.

### **License, Registration and Certificate:**

Candidates appointed to position in this classification are assigned duties that require the operation of motor vehicles. Employees are required to possess a motor vehicle operator's license valid in the State of Maryland. Applicants must list their driver license number and expiration date on the application.

Offer of employment will be made contingent upon the successful candidate successfully passing a medical examination and obtaining a valid US DOT medical card at the time of pre-employment physical. During the six months probationary period, the employee **will be required to obtain and maintain a valid Class A Commercial Driver License (CDL) with HAZMAT and TANKER endorsements valid in the State of Maryland that must be maintained for continued employment.** This includes obtaining and maintaining a valid US DOT Medical Card every two years.

Employee must meet all Department of Budget and Management policies required to operate state owned vehicles to continue employment.

Employees will be required to satisfy the agency's training and certification program requirements to obtain and maintain permanent status in this classification.

Candidates meeting minimum qualifications may be required to complete a supplementary standard questionnaire to progress to eligible list.
